

Does Kroger Accept EBT in 2022?

If you have a low income, you may be able to seek support from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) (SNAP). The USDA handles SNAP benefits and provides numerous avenues for consumers to apply. To apply for an EBT card, contact your nearest SNAP office.

You can discover your local offices on the USDA national map. Alternatively, all local offices are listed in each state directory or through your state's official website. Eligibility standards vary by jurisdiction, although most states offer the cards to persons with modest incomes.

Some states will accept applications from anyone who has an income below a specific level. Others could also look at aspects including whether or not the applicant has children and the applicant's existing spending.
